I hope you all are doing fine and in good HEALTH.

Because of you, we can make a big difference for our VFW Post and Veterans. When we asked for your support you gave help to your Post. 20% of our Membership / Auxiliary / Business, gave a donation to our operating fund. We also had support from our local business. Yes, we still had expenses to maintain the utilities, building &

from our local business. Yes, we still had expenses to maintain the utilities, building & grounds, taxes, insurance, cleaning, painting, and etc...

This is small business and when you close the doors, we still have those expenses. I worked on a loan through the PPP /Care Act and we did receive a small loan. Plans are to keep it in a reserve account in case we need the funds and then later must pay it back. At this time, we have used the loan funds to support the operating costs and will not have to pay this back. Thank You Huntington Bank for your support to get this PPP loan. I also filed through Macomb County for a Non-Profit Grant. We received a \$5000 grant and used the Grant money to replace the main cooler compressor that cost \$4100. I bring this up so that you know we have been on top of major problems.

What the membership voted on was a replacement for the Hall Roof and the replacement to the flat roof for the Club Room. We have applied for a loan through Huntington Bank to pay for the cost of both roofs. Donations toward the roof repairs would off set the cost of the loan. I have scheduled with a contractor to put us on his schedule come springtime.

Let us talk membership...we have 405 post members along with 238 Auxiliary members. The VFW membership year begins July 1,2020 and ends June 30,2021. I see that phone numbers have changed, and addresses are incorrect. If you want information from the Post or from the National VFW lets work together to correct the communications. VIFW IRemembers the Courage & Sacriffice of America's Iraq War Veterans

Until every service man and woman returns home, the commitment to our warfighters in harm's way must remain the same'

On this 9th anniversary of the conclusion of the U.S. mission in Iraq, the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) remembers the nearly 4,500 courageous men and women who paid the ultimate sacrifice in the fight against terror. More than 1.5 million soldiers, sailors, airmen, and Marines deployed to Iraq from March 20, 2003, to Dec. 18, 2011. "War and conflict comes at a significant cost – one that our military families continue to face long after the conclusion of the Iraq War," said VFW National Commander Harold "Hal" Roesch II. "Although the war may have concluded nine years ago, it's imperative we never forget the lives of the soldiers, sailors, airmen, and Marines lost in the global fight on terror and the grieving families who live in memory of these noble warriors." Several hundred U.S. troops remain in Iraq today in support of Operation Inherent Resolve, the U.S. military's intervention against the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria. "Until every service man and woman returns home, the commitment to our warfighters in harm's way must remain the same," said Roesch. "The support for our troops must be non-negotiable as they are the greatest gift our nation may ever receive as we continue to protect our democracy and fight the war on terror."


