Post Member Bio

The Battle of Iwo Jima was important because it provided a halfway point between the Marianas Islands and mainland Japan. Being so close to the island it would serve as an emergency landing point and a staging area for bombing runs. The U.S. invaded Iwo Jima as part of Admiral Nimitz's plan to hop from island to island in

the Pacific to reduce Japanese control. Iwo Jima is close enough to Japan for bombing runs and the Americans wanted to use the airfields already built there against the Japanese. About 21,000 Japanese defenders were killed in the battle of Iwo Jima. Of the attacking U.S. Marines and Navy, just under 7,000 died.

The Marines and Navy raised the American Flag on Mt. Suribachi Feb 23,1945. As a young man who joined the US Air Force Nov 1963, my first overseas assignment was on the island of Iwo Jima Sept. 1964 to Sept 1965. I served 1 year on a volcano supporting the communication, Air to ground and the Far East Network. It was all good and built my skill level. I was given the flag from the famous spot that it was

raised before I left the rock. (picture) I later was assigned to Homestead AFB in Florida, then within 6 or 7 months had orders to go back overseas. Spent 2 tours over in Vietnam and my 4 years in the Air Force ended my service to my country.

Time goes on working for a high-end computer company in the mid-west states for 27 years. My thoughts go back remembering that time when we were at war on this small island. Those that fought a war on Iwo Jima Island and raised the American flag on top of a volcano 700 miles from other islands in the Pacific. Did you know this was American territory and returned to the Japanese in 1973?

I call this, giving back to our veterans at Post 4659 for around 37 years. I hope it could last forever because the Post Vets are great. The Auxiliary is here to support the Post with there talents. We all make it happen together. We have some good team players. Come FEB 23 honoring those that did not return home please keep this in your hearts forever.


Canteen-Clubroom Notes


