POST 4659 Notes of Achievements in the Past Years

It was wonderful to see so many new faces as we are gathered for this year's election of officers. Many of you are not aware of the improvements that **the present administration** has made since the beginning of the Pandemic. I would like to apprise you all of these.

We have applied for and been awarded 3 PPP grants in the amounts of #1 \$8,927.00, #2 \$8,925.00 and #3 is currently pending....which has helped keep the Post afloat during the time the Post had to close and was not bringing in any money to pay the utilities, taxes, wages and day to day expenses.

We were fortunate to receive \$10,000 from Meijer to pay our bills as well as being able to help our veterans and employees with gift cards.

We had a new roofs/gutters and vents installed for \$38,000 and with the contributions we received from many businesses, Veterans, Post Members, Facebook, Go- Fund Me and General Public...our net cost was only \$14,000.

Our Post is #2 in the State of Michigan with membership of 102.55%.

We have made improvements in the hall with new barn doors between the kitchen and doorway to the clubroom. New air conditioner. During the shut-down the club was also repainted along with the bathrooms, new coolers were installed in the Post to support the beer/ pop/ wine, etc.

We have updated our Newsletter to include the 2-Month calendar insert. With support from the board /bingo mgt. /club mgt. / Auxiliary, and local businesses now pay their fair share to support the costs that helps the Post.

We have worked to help many Veterans and Post Members in need.

Our future projects include upgrading the ceiling in the club and make improvements on the back patio area along with landscaping with help from the Shelby Lions Club and the Post. working on the Wilson Road / Parking lots with Asphalt, Sealing and lots Striped

Driving for younger veterans to join our post is a must for our survival.

All this with very good positive results.






Congratulations to the new Post and Auxiliary Officers! Whether you've served in this capacity before, or you're new to the position, you have our best wishes for a successful year!

The Gold Star Families Memorial



On the other side of the monument, there are scenes etched on each of the four panels: Homeland, Family, Patriot and Sacrifice. At the center of this tribute, is a silhouette of a saluting

65th Infantry Regiment of the United States Army

WASHINGTON The VFW joins a grateful nation in commemorating National Borinqueneers Day, named in honor of the brave Soldiers of the 65th Infantry Regiment of the United States Army. Nicknamed during the Korean War for the original inhabitants of the island of Puerto Rico, the Borinqueneers have a long and storied history dating back to its inception as the first all-Hispanic military unit in 1899. Since then, the 65th would go on to serve with distinction in defending the Panama Canal Zone during WWI and North Africa, France and Germany in WWII.

During the Korean War, the 65th Infantry was heralded for their exceptional courage, tenacity and sacrifice. They were awarded battle participation credits for nine campaigns, lauded for their bravery at the Battle of Chosin Reservoir, and credited with the last battalion-sized bayonet charge in U.S. Army history. Among their numerous awards for valor from the Korean War are two Presidential Unit Citations, 2,771 Purple Heart Medals, 606 Bronze Stars, 256 Silver Stars, nine Distinguished Service Crosses, and the Medal of Honor.

On April 13, 2016, the Borinqueneers were awarded the Congressional Gold Medal for their many contributions to the Armed Forces of the United States. In January 2021, members of Congress passed legislation making National Borinqueneers Day law, celebrating this valorous unit for the first time April 13 last year.

Today, the legacy elements of 65th Infantry Regiment continue to serve where and when it's called upon as part of the Puerto Rican National Guard.

From all of the 1.5 million members of the VFW and its Auxiliary, we salute all Borinqueneers, both past, present and future, as well as all who serve in the U.S. military from Puerto Rico. Thank you for all you've done and continue to do for our great nation.


