our nation. On October I0th, I traveled to Lansing to attend and represent the Michigan VFW at the Governor's Signing Ceremony of the Bill forming a Michigan World War One Centennial Commission. Then. On Oct. 13-15, we went to Minneapolis, MN to attend the VFW's Big Ten Conference meeting. As a note, the National Organization is divided into 4 Conferences, The East, West, South and Big Ten. Michigan is Big Ten along with OH, IN, IL, WI, MN, NE. SD IA, and MO. No Rutgers or Maryland in our Big Ten.

Your Post is doing well and doing all the things that are required of us and we will continue doing just that.

Veterans Day is coming. Post 4659 will have our annual ceremony at 11:00am on Saturday, November 11, 2017. It will be held at our Post memorial and a luncheon will follow in the Post Hall. Come out and join us as we honor all of our nations' military veterans. Also, we will have a short ceremony to commemorate the Centennial of the American entry into World War One and honor the 2 Million American that served in Europe during the Great War (this war before we found the need to number World Wars).

After the first of the year, we will make applications available and begin accepting entries for our VFW Post 4659 Carl LaRock Memorial Scholarship from graduating High School Seniors in our area. This will be \$1,000 each for at least two winners and is paid for by the Scholarship fund set up with monies received from the will of deceased Post Member Carl LaRock. I would guess that we have awarded about \$80,000 to deserving students in our community over the past 20 year.

To have a successful year, the Post will take care of all other needed efforts but we need the assistance of every member to locate and recruit new members. As the VFW has long said, "Membership is the only thing we do for ourselves". Be a part of that. Wreaths Across America is an annual December event with a goal of decorating Veterans' gravesites with ceremonial wreaths.

This activity started over 25 years ago at Arlington National Cemetery and has now spread throughout the United States and around the world. Over 1.4 million ceremonial wreaths were placed last year.

For the past 9 years, VFW Post 4659, Old Settlers Post has supported our Post cemetery, Prestonville Cemetery, located on 25 Mile Road between Jewel and Schoenherr where there are 175 veteran gravesites.

The goal is to have 175 ceremonial wreaths placed by children on every veteran gravesite. To reach this goal we need help with contributions from individuals, families, businesses and local church groups
