




Post Member Bio

We honor one of our own Bruce Hartung, who joined the Marine Corps on September 7th 1967 and joined the VFW back in 1992. Bruce holds two Purple Heart medals from his service in the Marine Corps during the Vietnam War, initially launched the effort to obtain Purple Heart accreditation for the city of Rochester. The City Council approved a resolution and issued a



proclamation on August 15, 2015. "After two Purple Hearts, I'm happy to be alive and grateful to be on my third life," Hartung said. "I see this designation as a way to help raise awareness about the courage and sacrifice that each and every Purple

Canteen-Clubroom Notes


Comrades, Members and Friends

COLA Increase for Veterans and Survivors:

President Biden signed VFW-supported H.R. 7846, VeteransCompensation Cost-of-Living Adjustment Act of 2022 into law. Certain VA benefits including disability compensation, clothing allowances, and dependency and indemnity compensation for survivors will receive the same cost-of-living adjustment as Social Security benefits. The announced increase is to be 8.7 percent, which is higher than in recent years to account for inflation. The adjustment will go into effect on Dec. 1, 2022, and the first checks to reflect the new rate will be on Dec. 31, 2022.
